## **Course Description**

#### **Course Introduction**

In classical music, the notes change their role according to the Ragas. Same note behaves and sounds differently in different Ragas. Because the Uchcharan of the same note is different in different Ragas. Every Raga has its own way of interpreting and intertwining notes into phrases, without the study of which, the true essence of the Raga is not delivered. Students should study the Swarochcharan of every Raga to understand and maintain its true nature. This course is designed keeping in mind this importance of Swara-Uchcharan or Swarochcharan in Raga Music.

To introduce students with the concept Swarochchaaran

To train the students in Swarochchaaran of the prescribed Ragas from the Raga-Saadhana courses of the same semester

To develop the sense of differentiate between Ragas on the basis of Swarochchaaran
