Course Description

This is a regular core course for the postgraduate students of Hindustani vocal music. It focuses on 'Layakari' aspect of the Khayal improvisation.

Course Introduction

Layakari is an introduction of rhythmic variations with reference to an assumed Laya or tempo. The Post graduate level students must make use of different patterns of Laya in the Khayal improvisation. Right from the Aalaps, Taans, Bol-Taans and Bol-Prastaar, it is included in all the Anga-s of Khayal music. It enriches the presentation by adding the rhythmic play with the notes. After students are comfortable with the basic structure of Khayal presentation, they are introduced to Layakari which takes the performance to the next level. Audiences enjoy it more since they can easily relate to it. This course is designed to equip the students with the skills of using the Layakari-s in their performance. The course prescribes Ragas for detailed and non-detailed studies to exercise the studies of Layakari.

Course Objective

This course is designed with the following objectives –

- > To introduce students with the use of different rhythmic patterns
- > To train students for the Layakari in all Ang-s of Khayal such as Aalap, Bol-aalap, Taan, Bol-Prastaar etc.
- > To incorporate the rhythm visibly in the presentation of Khayal
- > To introduce different types of Layakari-s
- > To introduce new Ragas as prescribed in the syllabus

Course Outcome

After completion of this course, the students will be able to –



- 1. Show different Layakaris on hand with Taali (claps)
- 2. Implement Layakari-s in different Anga-s of Khayal
- 3. Entertain the audience using the Layakari-s in the presentation
- 4. Perform the prescribed Ragas in concert
